Scholarship

21 pupils from Honors Academy, Chegutu, had their fees paid for the 2019 first term under the BAK Scholarship programme. A further group of 10 from Open tribe Foundation from Epworth makeshift school was added on the scholarship. A total of \$360.00 was pulled through our scholarship beneficiaries for the children at Honors Academy. The 21 children were put into 3 groups for teachers and BAK admins monitor the children's performance. The 10 children at OTF were profiled and assessed and the school fees total will be deposited starting with the month of March 2019.

Donation from BAK

19 children from Honours Academy received school shoes which we donated in memory of Thabani. The gesture started last year with a total of at least 37 children benefiting from the initiative to date. We are hoping that with the support we are getting from our partners, well-wishers and voluntary team we will be able to raise more money to help more children with school uniforms.

Donations for BAK

One of our friends, Mr Stan Flowers donated a trailer to BAK a gesture that synced well with our plans of buying a bigger vehicle for our team of volunteers and operations. The trailer will be vital as much as we are working in and around Harare and also travelling to areas like Chegutu. A total of US\$270.00 was used for used change of ownership and registering the trailer under BAK.

Associations and agreements

In February we have managed to grow our partners portfolio as we started working with Chenegto Zimbabwe Trust. Through Chengeto we also engaged with Open Trust Foundation Zimbabwe, an organisation working with children and the elderly in EPWORTH, HARARE. Our association with Honors Academy is also flourishing and Tag Rugby Trust Zimbabwe is also working in training school children in tag rugby. We have also been listed as Icon Rally's official charity organisation partner and the team has contributed GBP350.00 and also pledged to pay fees for 10 children.

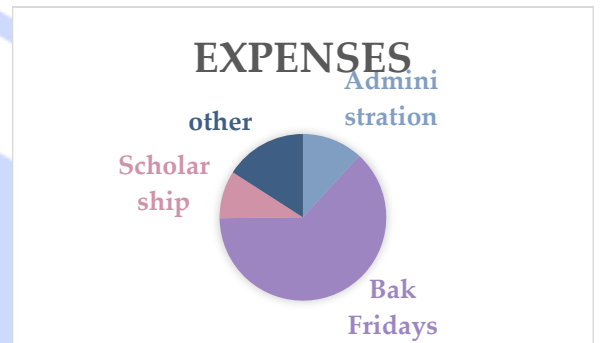
BAK Fridays

Two main BAK events were held in February at Honors Academy and at Mukuvisi Woodlands for OTF children. The HA event was held on the 8th of Feb and Chengeto Zimbabwe Trust and Tag Rugby Zimbabwe Trust were present at the event. A total of 150 children took part in games which were organised for the day and were fed after the program. A total of US\$463.00 was used for the day's expenses.

The Mukuvisi Woodland educational trip was on the 22nd of February and 73 children from OTF were hosted at the recreational park for the whole day. The children participated in a number of activities including touring the place, games, jumping castle and photoshoot. We also managed to pull 16 volunteers and a total of US\$606.00 was used for all costs for the day.
